REPORTED QUESTIONS

A question in reported speech is no longer a question. Therefore:

- there is no auxiliary that changes order with the subject
- the auxiliaries "do/does/did" are not used
- there is no question mark (?)

REPORTED QUESTIONS

In direct speech there are two types of questions:

a) Starting with an auxiliary:

Bill: Sarah, **are** you on a diet? Betty: **Did** he sing that song? Paul: **Have** you studied Italian?



REPORTED QUESTIONS

b) Starting with an interrogative pronoun:

Greg: **What** are you doing? Frank: **Where** has he gone? Peter: **How** will we go there?

REPORTED QUESTIONS

To report these questions we use "to ask" and:

a) If the question starts with an auxiliary, in reported speech we need "if" (or "whether"):

Bill asked if Sarah was on a diet.

Betty asked if he had sung that song.

Paul asked me if I had studied Italian.

REPORTED QUESTIONS

b) If the guestion starts with an interrogative pronoun, it is also used in reported speech.

> Greg asked me what I was doing. Frank asked where he had gone. Peter asked **how** they would get there.

REPORTED QUESTIONS

ask = want to know

Greg wanted to know what I was doing.

Frank wanted to know where he had gone.

Peter wanted to know how they would get there.

ADVANCED

REPORTED COMMANDS

ask / tell + somebody + to + infinitive

James: Go out!

James asked me to go out.

John: Open the door!

John told me to open the door.

ADVANCED

REPORTED COMMANDS

Negative commands.

not + to + infinitive

Barbara: Don't get up late!

Barbara told us **not to get up** late.

Linda: Don't go there by train.

Linda asked me **not to go** there by train.
