ADVERBS OF FREQUENCY

Position of adverbs of frequency:

- 1) After an auxiliary verb (to be).

I am usually at home.
He is never late.

ADVERBS OF FREQUENCY

Position of adverbs of frequency:

- 2) Before a non-auxiliary verb.

You **rarely** wash your car.
Does she **always** buy the newspaper?
They **sometimes** watch the news on TV.

ADVERBS OF FREQUENCY

Position of adverbs of frequency:

- 3) Sometimes they are placed at the beginning or end of a sentence.

I **sometimes** go to the gym.
Sometimes I go to the gym.
I go to the gym **sometimes**.

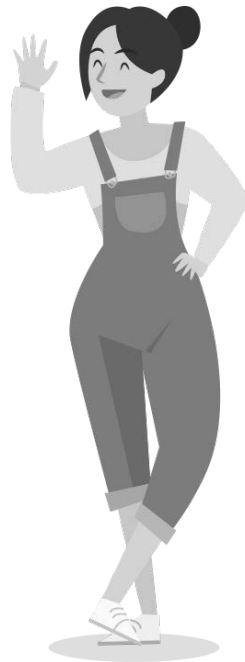
