ADVERBS OF FREQUENCY

Position of adverbs of frequency:

1) After an auxiliary verb (to be).

I am usually at home. He is never late.



ADVERBS OF FREQUENCY

Position of adverbs of frequency:

Before a non-auxiliary verb.

You rarely wash your car. Does she always buy the newspaper? They sometimes watch the news on TV.

Position of adverbs of frequency:

3) Sometimes they are placed at the beginning or end of a sentence.

> I sometimes go to the gym. Sometimes I go to the gym. I go to the gym sometimes.
