Adjectives are used for descriptions.

She is **tall**.
That girl is very **intelligent**.

This car is **expensive**.
These cars are **expensive**.

This house is **expensive**. These houses are **expensive**.



ADJECTIVES

ADJECTIVE + NOUN

It's a difficult <u>exercise</u>.
They are **good** <u>students</u>.
That **slim** <u>boy</u> is my brother.

ADVERBS OF INTENSITY

very

pretty

quite

Examples:

She cooks **very** <u>well</u>.
The exam is **pretty** <u>difficult</u>.
That movie is **quite** interesting.

ADVERBS OF INTENSITY

pretty (adjective)

She is **pretty**. (= beautiful)

pretty (adverb)

She is pretty funny. (=very)

intelligent cheerful thin, slim fat, overweight

absent-minded handsome / pretty ugly
