THERE IS + UNCOUNTABLE NOUN

There is some milk in the glass.

THERE IS + COUNTABLE NOUN (SINGULAR)

There is a church on Galven Street.

Contraction:

there is = **there's**

There's a computer on the desk.

INGLÉS

"THERE IS" AND "THERE ARE"

THERE ARE + COUNTABLE NOUN (PLURAL)

There are two shops near my house.

"THERE IS" AND "THERE ARE"

Negative forms:

there isn't (there is not)

there aren't (there are not)

There isn't a bank there.

There aren't three hotels in the city.
