When an uncountable noun is the subject of a sentence, the verb is conjugated in the 3rd person singular.

Olive oil **is** expensive, but healthy.
 There **is** some sugar on the table.

USES OF "SOME" AND "ANY"

SOME (affirmative sentences)

- Before uncountable nouns.

There **is some** water in the glass.

- Before countable nouns.

There **are some** eggs in the fridge.

ANY (negative sentences)

- Before uncountable nouns.

There isn't **any** sugar for the cake.

- Before countable nouns.

There aren't **any** pencils in the shop.

ANY (questions)

- Before uncountable nouns.

Is there **any** money in that piggy bank?

- Before countable nouns.

Are there **any** pictures on the wall?
