much + uncountable noun

"A lot of" is used in affirmative sentences.

"**Much**" and "**many**" are used in negative sentences and questions (although "**many**" may also appear in some affirmative sentences).

Examples:

I have **a lot of** books.

She doesn't have **much** money.

Are there **many** students in the classroom?

Small quantity: **little, few**

little + uncountable noun

few + countable noun

QUANTIFIERS: LITTLE, FEW

"**Little**" and "**few**" are used in affirmative, negative and interrogative sentences.

They indicate **small quantity of something, with the meaning of "not enough"**.

QUANTIFIERS: LITTLE, FEW

Examples:

There is **little** sugar for the cake.

Are there **few** hamburgers?

QUANTIFIERS: A LITTLE, A FEW

Small quantity: **a little, a few**

a little + uncountable noun

a few + countable noun

QUANTIFIERS: A LITTLE, A FEW

"**A little**" and "**a few**" are used in affirmative, negative and interrogative sentences.

They indicate a **small but enough quantity of something**.

QUANTIFIERS: A LITTLE, A FEW

Examples:

There is **a little** sugar for the cake.

Are there **a few** hamburgers?

QUANTIFIERS: (A) LITTLE, (A) FEW

Examples:

I have **little** money. VS I have **a little** money.

She has **few** dollars. VS She has **a few** dollars.

How much + uncountable noun ...?

- How much milk is there in the fridge?
- There is little milk.

- **How many cakes** are there on the table?
- There are a lot of cakes.

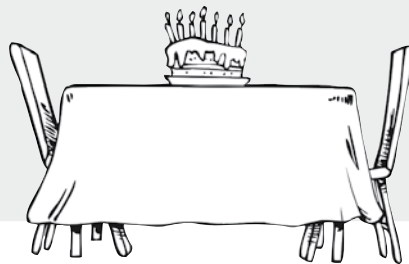
