ADVERBS OF MANNER

a) Adjective + "ly"

slow → slowly  
 quick → quickly  
 quiet → quietly  
 careful → carefully

The girl is sleeping **quietly**.

ADVERBS OF MANNER

b) Adjective (-y) + "ly" → "-ily"

easy → easily  
 happy → happily

I can learn these rules **easily**.

c) Adjective (-le) → "-ly"

terrible → terribly  
 gentle → gently

The wind blows **gently**.

d) Adjective (-ic) → "-ically"

automatic → automatically

This machine works **automatically**.

### ADVERBS OF MANNER

Some adjectives = Adverbs of manner


<u>adjective</u>	<b>adverb</b>
fast	<b>fast</b>
hard	<b>hard</b>

It's a **hard** job. (adjective)

They work **hard**. (adverb)

### ADVERBS OF MANNER

good  well

He is a **good** painter. (adjective)

He paints **well**. (adverb)

### ADVERBS OF MANNER

When modifying a verb, they are usually placed after it.

She is eating **quickly**.

They speak **perfectly**.

Verb + complement + **adverb of manner**

~~Verb + **adverb of manner** + complement~~

She is eating the apple **quickly**.

They speak English **perfectly**.
