adjective adverb
fast fast
hard hard

It's a **hard** job. (adjective) They work **hard**. (adverb)

He is a **good** painter. (adjective) He paints **well**. (adverb)

ADVERBS OF MANNER

When modifying a verb, they are usually placed after it.

She is eating quickly. They speak perfectly.

Verb + complement + adverb of manner
Verb + adverb of manner + complement

She is eating the apple quickly. They speak English perfectly.
