There was some milk in the glass.

There was a bus in front of the post office.

There were + plural countable noun

There were some shops near my house.

There were ten people at the meeting.

INGLÉS

"THERE WAS" AND "THERE WERE"

Negative form:

there wasn't = there was not

there weren't = there were not

There wasn't any honey.

There weren't many people at the concert.

Questions:

Was there ...? / Were there ...?

Was there a car near the sidewalk?

Were there any supermarkets?

"THERE WAS" AND "THERE WERE"

Short answers:

- Was there a car near the sidewalk?
- **Yes, there was.**
- Were there any supermarkets?
- **No, there weren't.**

ASKING FOR A PRODUCT

- FORMAL: **I'd like to have / take**
I'd like to take some magazines.
- NEUTRAL: **I'll take**
I'll take a bottle of milk.
- COLLOQUIAL: **I want**
I want a blue dress.

ASKING ABOUT PRICES

- How much + "to be" ...?
- Subject + "to be" ...

How much is the newspaper?

The newspaper is \$1.20

It is \$1.20

How much are the potatoes?

The potatoes are \$0.50 a pound.

They are \$0.50 a pound.

How much + "to cost"?

- How much does the car cost?
- It costs a lot of money.
