PAST SIMPLE OF REGULAR VERBS

Negative form:

Subject + **didn't (did not) + infinitive ...**

Aff.: She answered the question.

Neg.: She **didn't answer** the question.

Aff.: Leo wanted an ice-cream.

Neg.: Leo **didn't want** an ice-cream.

PAST SIMPLE OF REGULAR VERBS

Examples:

My mother **didn't live** in the USA.

They **didn't work** in the morning.

I **didn't open** the window.

PAST SIMPLE OF REGULAR VERBS

Questions:

Did + subject + verb (infinitive) ...?

Aff.: They cleaned their rooms.

Que.: **Did they clean** their rooms?

Aff.: She listened to me.

Que.: **Did she listen** to me?

PAST SIMPLE OF REGULAR VERBS

Examples:

Did you travel to Europe last year?

When **did she visit** her family?

Why **did Peter stop** the car?

PAST SIMPLE OF REGULAR VERBS

Short answers:

Did you like the movie?

Yes, I did.

No, I didn't.

ADVERBS OF PLACE

over here

out, outside

over there

in, inside

up, upstairs

in front

down, downstairs

behind

near, nearby

around

far (away)

ADVERBS OF PLACE

Examples:

The cat is **over there**.

Maureen lives **downstairs**.

The school isn't **near** here. It's very **far**.

The girls are **outside** but the boys are **inside**.
