"BY" + MEANS OF TRANSPORT

I go to work **by** <u>bus</u>.

They always travel **by** <u>train</u>.

How often do you travel **by** <u>plane</u>?

But: on foot

Mrs. O'Hara never goes to school on foot.

IN + a car ON + a bus / train / ship / plane The kids are in the car. The driver wasn't on the bus.
