They **aren't as old as** us.

## THE COMPARATIVE OF EQUALITY

In negative sentences:

not as + adjective  
adverb + as

My computer **isn't as good as** this one.

My computer **isn't so good as** this one.

## THE COMPARATIVE OF EQUALITY

Susan is very pretty.

Betty **isn't so pretty (as Susan)**.

**not as/so many + countable noun + as**

He's rich. I **don't** have **as much money (as him)**.

There **aren't so many bananas as** yesterday.

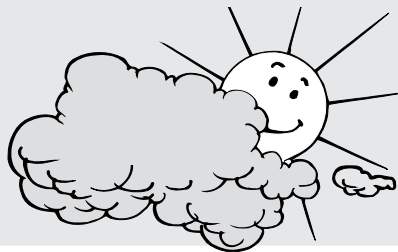
