

THE PRONOUNS "ONE" AND "ONES"

"One" replaces a singular noun.

"Ones" replaces a plural noun.

This book is interesting but that **one** is boring.
("one" replaces "book")

I like that car. I don't like these **ones**.
("ones" replaces "cars")

THE PRONOUNS "ONE" AND "ONES"

More examples:

- That's my dictionary.

- Which **one**?

("one" replaces "dictionary")

Do you prefer green grapes or black **ones**?
("ones" replaces "grapes")

THE PREPOSITION "FOR"

Uses of "for":

a) direction, to a particular person/object:

This is **for** her.

b) with the object or purpose of:

This key is **for** opening doors.

THE PREPOSITION "FOR"

Uses of "for":

c) reason:

She is famous **for** her songs.

d) in search of:

She's gone **for** some cakes.



THE PREPOSITION "FOR"

Uses of "for":

e) with meals:

I had chicken **for** lunch.

f) in exchange for:

He bought his house **for** a lot of money.

THE PREPOSITION "FOR"

Uses of "for":

g) destination:

That's the train **for** New York.

h) duration:

I was living in Madrid **for** two years.

i) prepositional verbs:

She's looking **for** her purse.
