

"BE GOING TO" + INFINITIVE

am
are
is } going to + infinitive

- 1) Future plans or intentions:
She **is going to buy** a magazine.
- 2) Future predictions (with evidence):
It's cloudy. It's **going to rain**.

"BE GOING TO" + INFINITIVE

In affirmative sentences:

He **is going to make** a cake.

They **are going to be** late.

You're **going to learn** many things.

He's **going to listen** to the radio.

"BE GOING TO" + INFINITIVE

In negative sentences:

Am not / aren't / isn't + going to + infinitive

I **am not going to write** a book.

They **aren't going to sell** their apartment.

"BE GOING TO" + INFINITIVE

In questions:

am / are / is + subject + going to + infinitive ...?

Are you going to buy a dictionary?

Where **is your sister going to live**?

"BE GOING TO" + INFINITIVE

In short answers:

Are you going to see the match on TV?
Yes, I am.

Is he going to be your teacher?
No, he isn't.

"BE GOING TO" + INFINITIVE

going to \Rightarrow gonna

We're going to move house.



We're **gonna** move house.

"BE GOING TO" + INFINITIVE

Verbs "to go" and "to come":

~~going to go~~ \Rightarrow **going to**

~~going to come~~ \Rightarrow **coming to**

I'm going to the movies on Saturday.
They're coming to the meeting.
