I **know** him very well.
She **knows** the president.

Places: I **know** London well.

- These views are beautiful!
- Yes, I **agree**.

Examples:

- Eating vegetables is healthy.
- Yes, I **agree with that**.
- I want to go to university.
- I **agree with you**. It's a great idea!

DISAGREEMENT:

I don't agree = I disagree

- Going to the beach is a good plan for the weekend.
- **I disagree.** It's going to rain.

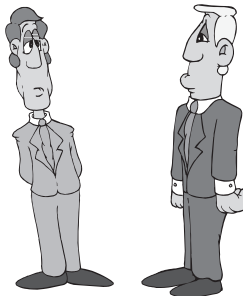
