They were <u>here yesterday</u>.

Did you work <u>hard last year</u>?

Is the baby sleeping <u>quietly on the couch now</u>?

Examples:

**First** I got up, **then** I took a shower, **after that** I had breakfast and, **finally**, I took the children to school.

When she gets home, **first** she has dinner and **then** she watches TV.




after that = later, then
