Usual order: **manner, place, time**

She is dancing happily at the disco.

They were here yesterday.

Did you work hard last year?

Is the baby sleeping quietly on the couch now?

EXPRESSIONS SHOWING THE ORDER OR SEQUENCE OF EVENTS

First
Then
After that
Later
Finally

EXPRESSIONS SHOWING THE ORDER OR SEQUENCE OF EVENTS

Examples:

First I got up, **then** I took a shower, **after that** I had breakfast and, **finally**, I took the children to school.

When she gets home, **first** she has dinner and **then** she watches TV.

EXPRESSIONS SHOWING THE ORDER OR SEQUENCE OF EVENTS

after ≠ later, then

after + (det.) + noun

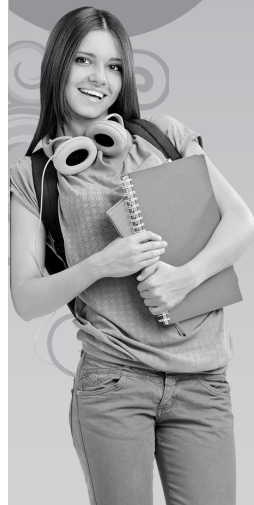
We went for a walk **after** the meal.

after that = later, then

We have to study now but we can watch TV **after that**.

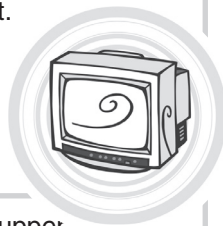
