

"STILL" AND "YET"

Still → affirmative sentences and questions

a) After auxiliary verbs in affirmative sentences:

I'm **still** watching TV.

She can **still** drive.

In questions (the auxiliary changes position):

Is he **still** waiting for you?

Can he **still** play soccer?

"STILL" AND "YET"

Still → affirmative sentences and questions

b) Before non-auxiliary verbs in affirmative sentences and questions:

I **still** go to the gym.

She **still** has some savings.

Does he **still** smoke?

"STILL" AND "YET"

Yet → negative sentences

"Yet" is always placed at the end of the sentence:

I'm not having lunch **yet**.

He doesn't work **yet**.

BOTH...AND... / EITHER...OR... / NEITHER...NOR...

a) Both

Both men are Mexican.

I like **both** cars.

Both ... and ...

Both John **and** Mike are politicians.

Both you **and** I have children.

b) Either ... or ...

We can **either** watch TV **or** listen to music.

c) Neither ... nor ...

Neither you **nor** your children like beans.
