WITH "FOR" AND "SINCE"

for + period of time
How long ...?
since + a point in time

ADVANCED THE PRESENT PERFECT WITH "FOR" AND "SINCE"

FOR

I've lived in Chicago **for** <u>five</u> <u>years</u>. She has played the guitar **for** <u>two</u> <u>months</u>.

SINCE

I've lived in Chicago **since** <u>2007</u>. She has played the guitar **since** <u>January</u>.
