present perfect + ever, never past experiences

"Ever" is used in questions and placed before the past participle.

Has she ever been to the USA?

Have you ever done a crossword?

### THE PRESENT PERFECT ADVANCED WITH "EVER" AND "NEVER"

present perfect + ever, never past experiences

"Never" is used in affirmative sentences and also placed before the past participle.

They have never been to Brazil.

- Have you ever eaten sushi?
- No, I have never eaten sushi.
- Has he ever won a prize?
- No, he has never won a prize.

### THE PRESENT PERFECT ADVANCED WITH "EVER" AND "NEVER"

Superlative + "ever"

This is the most interesting book (that) I have ever read.

He's the tallest boy she has ever seen.

present perfect + other adverbs of frequency

I have sometimes watched that program.

They **have** always **been** very generous.

I lived in Washington for a year.

The **present perfect** is used when the action may continue in the present.

I have lived in Washington for a year.


