"EACH" AND "EVERY"

Each: every one separately
Every: each, all

Same meaning:

Prices go up **each** year.
 Prices go up **every** year.

ADVANCED

Level

"EACH" AND "EVERY"

Different meaning:

Each: one by one

Each artist paints differently.
 She spoke to **each** of the students.
 I gave a toy to **each** of them.

ADVANCED

Level

"EACH" AND "EVERY"

Different meaning:

Every: singular, but in a group

Every artist is sensitive.
Every person can speak English.

"EACH" AND "EVERY"

For 2 things → ~~every~~ each

He was carrying a suitcase in **each** hand.

ADVANCED

Level

"EACH" AND "EVERY"

The verbs whose subject is
"each" or "every" + a noun or a pronoun
are conjugated as the 3rd person singular.

Each of them **has** a computer.

Every couch **is** comfortable.

"EACH" AND "EVERY"

"Every" → frequency

There is a plane to Bangkok **every day**.

The bus leaves **every hour**.

ADVANCED

Vocabulary: WAYS OF COOKING

to cook	to barbecue	to microwave

to boil	to poach	fried
to braise	to steam	grilled
to fry	to stew	toasted

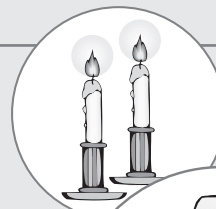
