## MULTI-WORD VERBS

### PHRASAL VERBS

Type 1) Verb + adverb

I **get up** at seven.

Type 2) Verb + adverb + object

She **looked up** a word in the dictionary.

## MULTI-WORD VERBS

### PREPOSITIONAL VERBS

Type 3) Verb + preposition + object

They were **looking for** their keys.

## MULTI-WORD VERBS

### PHRASAL – PREPOSITIONAL VERBS

Type 4) Verb + adverb + preposition + object

We have **run out of** sugar.

Adverbs and prepositions may make the verbs change their original meaning:

be over

come across

run out of

## PHRASAL VERBS (TYPE 1)

### VERB + ADVERB

come in	run away
go out	be back
sit down	be over
shut up	fall down
break down	get up
stand up

## PHRASAL VERBS (TYPE 1)

Examples:

The children **came in** and **sat down**.

The storm **is over**.

Her grandmother **fell down** yesterday.

Are you **going out** tonight?

NOT

I think so	I don't think so
I suppose so	I suppose not
I guess so	I guess not
I hope so	I hope not
I'm afraid so	I'm afraid not

## GIVING OPINIONS

Examples:

Did his truck break down? **I think so**.

Is any bank open now? **I suppose so**.

Will you get good qualifications? **I hope so**.

Will he get up at 7 tomorrow? **No, I'm afraid not**.
