## PREPOSITIONAL VERBS (TYPE 3)

## VERB + PREPOSITION + OBJECT

look after	look for
come across	break into
talk about	wait for
get over	look into

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## PREPOSITIONAL VERBS (TYPE 3)

Examples:

 My mother is **looking after** my children.

 My mother is **looking after** them.

 I **came across** them in Madrid.

 Are you **waiting for** your friends?

 She was **talking about** that.

 Peter is **looking for** his glasses.

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## PREPOSITIONAL VERBS (TYPE 3)

In questions, the preposition is usually placed at the end of the sentence:

 Who are you looking **after**?

 What was she talking **about**?

(TYPE 4)

## VERB + ADVERB + PREPOSITION + OBJECT

look down on

run out of

get on with

cut down on

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## PHRASAL PREPOSITIONAL VERBS (TYPE 4)

Examples:

We have **run out of** milk.

We have **run out of** it.

How do you **get on with** your neighbors?

You must **cut down on** cigarettes.

She **looks down on** everybody.
