# ADVANCED

### PREPOSITIONAL VERBS (TYPE 3)

### Examples:

My mother is looking after my children.

My mother is looking after them.

I came across them in Madrid.

Are you waiting for your friends?

She was talking about that.

Peter is looking for his glasses.



### PREPOSITIONAL VERBS (TYPE 3)

In questions, the preposition is usually placed at the end of the sentence:

Who are you looking after?

What was she talking **about**?

# PHRASAL PREPOSITIONAL VERBS (TYPE 4)

**VERB + ADVERB + PREPOSITION + OBJECT** 

look down on run out of get on with cut down on







### Examples:

We have **run out of** <u>milk</u>.

We have **run out of** <u>it</u>.

How do you **get on with** <u>your neighbors</u>?

You must **cut down on** <u>cigarettes</u>.

She **looks down on** everybody.
