### ADVANCED "SO" AND "SUCH"

SO:

a) So + adjective

Don't be so naughty! The house is so expensive that I can't buy it.

b) So + adverb

She speaks **so slowly** that you can understand her very well.

It is **so late** that we will have to take a cab.

#### SUCH:

a) Such + a(n) + adjective + singular noun It's such a nice movie!

It was such an interesting book that I read it quickly.

b) Such + (adjective) + uncountable / plural noun They were **such expensive pictures** that I couldn't buy them.

Most students discuss **such topics** in class.

ADVANCED Level	"SO" AND "SUCH"	
Both "so" and "such" emphasize the meaning of the adjective (or adverb).		
The conference was <b>so boring</b> that I left.		
It was <b>such a boring conference</b> that I left.		

ADVANCED Level	REFLEXIVE PRONOUNS
myself	ourselves
yourself	yourselves
himself herself itself	themselves





ADVANCED **REFLEXIVE PRONOUNS** 

Examples:

I cut **myself** with a knife.

She is looking at **herself** in the mirror.

Do they want to hurt themselves?

ADVANCED REFLEXIVE PRONOUNS

Singular forms: -self Plural forms: -selves

You washed yourself.

You washed yourselves.

ADVANCED **REFLEXIVE PRONOUNS** 

Reflexive pronouns are also used to emphasize the subject.

I did it myself.

Did he solve the problem **himself**?
