OF CONDITIONAL SENTENCES

It is impossible that the condition will be fulfilled because it refers to the past.

If + subject + **verb (past perfect) ...**,
subject + **verb (would + have + past participle)**

If I **had studied** harder, I **would have passed** the exam.

OF CONDITIONAL SENTENCES

More examples:

If you **had driven** more carefully, you **wouldn't have had** the accident.

If you **had stayed** at home, what **would** you **have done**?

would ⇒ could
might

If it had snowed we **could** have gone skiing.

"DURING", "FOR" AND "WHILE"

"**During**" is a preposition that is used when we refer to an activity or to the activity that takes place in a period of time.

We were speaking about politics **during the meal**.

I'll read some books **during the summer**.

"DURING", "FOR" AND "WHILE"

"**For**" is another preposition that refers to the duration of an activity. It is followed by a period of time.

She was studying **for** six hours.

I have been working **for** some months.

"DURING", "FOR" AND "WHILE"

"**While**" is a conjunction and precedes a subject and a verb.

I was watching TV **while** you were sleeping.
