TO + INFINITIVE

I'm learning English to get a good job.

They are going downtown **to visit** some friends.

### ADVANCED THE INFINITIVE OF PURPOSE

Common mistake:

I went to the butcher's for to buy some meat.

## ADVANCED OTHER USES OF INFINITIVES

a) After interrogative pronouns:

Can you tell me how to get to the town hall?

I didn't know what to do.

She wanted to know where to stay.

### ADVANCED INFINITIVES AFTER ADJECTIVES

I'm **pleased to meet** you.

They are sorry to hear that.

Are you happy to see me?

It's **important to speak** other languages.





# ADVANCED OTHER USES OF INFINITIVES

b) After indefinite pronouns (somebody, anything, nowhere, etc.):

There was nothing to eat.

I need somebody to help me.


